- 1. 2 Samuel 23:2 The Spirit of the LORD spake by me, and his word was in my tongue.
- 2. Job 6:24 Teach me, and I will hold my tongue: and cause me to understand wherein I have erred.
- 3. Psalms 12:3 The LORD shall cut off all flattering lips, and the tongue that speaketh proud things:
- 4. Psalms 34:13 Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile.
- 5. Psalms 35:28 And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness and of thy praise all the day long.
- 6. Psalms 39:1 I said, I will take heed to my ways, that I sin not with my tongue: I will keep my mouth with a bridle, while the wicked is before me.
- 7. Psalms 120:2 Deliver my soul, O LORD, from lying lips, and from a deceitful tongue.
- 8. Psalms 126:2 Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the heathen, The LORD hath done great things for them.
- 9. Proverbs 15:4 A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.
- 10. Proverbs 16:1 The preparations of the heart in man, and the answer of the tongue, is from the LORD.
- 11. Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.
