## Rally Theme – “Soldiers of The Cross”

1. Philippians 1:3 I thank my God upon every remembrance of you,
2. Philippians 1:4 Always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy,
3. Philippians 1:5 For your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now;
4. Philippians 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform *it* until the day of Jesus Christ:
5. Philippians 1:7 Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace.
6. Philippians 1:8 For God is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ.
7. Philippians 1:9 And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and *in* all judgment;
8. Philippians 1:10 That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;
9. Philippians 1:11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.
10. Philippians 1:12 But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the things *which happened* unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel;
11. Philippians 1:13 So that my bonds in Christ are manifest in all the palace, and in all other *places*;
12. Philippians 1:14 And many of the brethren in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.
13. Philippians 1:15 Some indeed preach Christ even of envy and strife; and some also of good will:
14. Philippians 1:16 The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds:
15. Philippians 1:17 But the other of love, knowing that I am set for the defence of the gospel.
16. Philippians 1:18 What then? notwithstanding, every way, whether in pretence, or in truth, Christ is preached; and I therein do rejoice, yea, and will rejoice.
17. Philippians 1:19 For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ,
18. Philippians 1:20 According to my earnest expectation and *my* hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but *that* with all boldness, as always, *so* now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether *it be* by life, or by death.
19. Philippians 1:21 For to me to live *is* Christ, and to die *is* gain.
20. Philippians 1:22 But if I live in the flesh, this *is* the fruit of my labour: yet what I shall choose I wot not.
21. Philippians 1:23 For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better:
22. Philippians 1:24 Nevertheless to abide in the flesh *is* more needful for you.
23. Philippians 1:25 And having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of faith;
24. Philippians 1:26 That your rejoicing may be more abundant in Jesus Christ for me by my coming to you again.
25. Philippians 1:27 Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;
