Rally Theme – “Pressing For The Prize”

1. Romans 13:1 Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God.
2. Romans 13:2 Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.
3. Romans 13:3 For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same:
4. Romans 13:4 For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to *execute* wrath upon him that doeth evil.
5. Romans 13:5 Wherefore *ye* must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake.
6. Romans 13:6 For for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing.
7. Romans 13:7 Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute *is due*; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.
8. Romans 13:8 Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.
9. Romans 13:9 For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if *there be* any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
10. Romans 13:10 Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love *is* the fulfilling of the law.
11. Romans 13:11 And that, knowing the time, that now *it is* high time to awake out of sleep: for now *is* our salvation nearer than when we believed.
12. Romans 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.
13. Romans 13:13 Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.
14. Romans 13:14 But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to *fulfil* the lusts *thereof*.
15. 2 Peter 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:
16. 2 Peter 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.
17. 2 Peter 1:5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;
18. 2 Peter 1:6 And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;
19. 2 Peter 1:7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
20. 2 Peter 1:8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make *you that ye shall* neither *be* barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
21. 2 Peter 1:9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.
22. Proverbs 28:13 He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.
23. Proverbs 24:1 Be not thou envious against evil men, neither desire to be with them.
24. Proverbs 24:2 For their heart studieth destruction, and their lips talk of mischief.
25. Proverbs 24:3 Through wisdom is an house builded; and by understanding it is established:
