- 1. Psalm 18:30 As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.
- 2. Psalm 18:31 For who is God save the LORD? or who is a rock save our God?
- 3. Psalm 18:32 It is God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect.
- 4. Psalm 18:33 He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and setteth me upon my high places.
- 5. Psalm 18:34 He teacheth my hands to war, so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms.
- 6. Psalm 18:35 Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great.
- 7. Psalm 18:36 Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, that my feet did not slip.
- 8. Psalm 18:37 I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed.
- 9. Psalm 18:49 Therefore will I give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto thy name.
- 10. Psalm 18:50 Great deliverance giveth he to his king; and sheweth mercy to his anointed, to David, and to his seed for evermore.
- 11. John 10:25 Jesus answered them, I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me.
- 12. John 10:26 But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you.
- 13. John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
- 14. John 10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.
- 15. John 10:29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.
- 16. John 10:30 I and my Father are one.
- 17. John 10:31 Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.
- 18. John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.
- 19. John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- 20. Colossians 2:10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:
- 21. Colossians 2:13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;
- 22. Colossians 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;
- 23. Colossians 2:15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.
- 24. James 3:13 Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.
- 25. James 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.
