Acts 3 & 4

Memory Theme – “Acceptable Acquaintances”

1. Psalm 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.
2. Psalm 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.
3. Psalm 1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
4. Psalm 1:4 The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away.
5. Psalm 1:5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.
6. Psalm 1:6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
7. Psalm 5:5 The foolish shall not stand in thy sight: thou hatest all workers of iniquity.
8. Proverbs 13:20 He that walketh with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.
9. Proverbs 28:7 Whoso keepeth the law is a wise son: but he that is a companion of riotous men shameth his father.
10. Proverbs 29:3 Whoso loveth wisdom rejoiceth his father: but he that keepeth company with harlots spendeth his substance.
11. John 17:14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
12. Acts 4:13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.
13. 2 Corinthians 7:4 Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my glorying of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding joyful in all our tribulation.
14. 1 Peter 1:15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;
15. 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.
16. 2 Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;
17. 2 Peter 2:5 And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;
18. 2 Peter 2:6 And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;
19. 2 Peter 2:7 And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked:
20. 2 Peter 2:8 (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;)
21. 2 Peter 2:9 The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:
22. 1 Peter 2:15 For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:
23. 1 Peter 2:16 As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.
24. 1 Peter 2:17 Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.
25. 1 Peter 2:21 For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:
