Ephesians 6 &
II Timothy 2

Rally Theme – “Soldiers of The Cross”

1. Exodus 9:29 And Moses said unto him, As soon as I am gone out of the city, I will spread abroad my hands unto the LORD; *and* the thunder shall cease, neither shall there be any more hail; that thou mayest know how that the earth *is* the LORD'S.
2. Exodus 9:33 And Moses went out of the city from Pharaoh, and spread abroad his hands unto the LORD: and the thunders and hail ceased, and the rain was not poured upon the earth.
3. Ruth 2:12 The LORD recompense thy work, and a full reward be given thee of the LORD God of Israel, under whose wings thou art come to trust.
4. Ruth 3:9 And he said, Who *art* thou? And she answered, I *am* Ruth thine handmaid: spread therefore thy skirt over thine handmaid; for thou *art* a near kinsman.
5. Ruth 3:10 And he said, Blessed *be* thou of the LORD, my daughter: *for* thou hast shewed more kindness in the latter end than at the beginning, inasmuch as thou followedst not young men, whether poor or rich.
6. Ruth 3:11 And now, my daughter, fear not; I will do to thee all that thou requirest: for all the city of my people doth know that thou *art* a virtuous woman.
7. Ruth 3:12 And now it is true that I *am thy* near kinsman: howbeit there is a kinsman nearer than I.
8. Psalm 9:1 To the chief Musician upon Muthlabben, A Psalm of David. I will praise *thee*, O LORD, with my whole heart; I will shew forth all thy marvellous works.
9. Psalm 9:2 I will be glad and rejoice in thee: I will sing praise to thy name, O thou most High.
10. Psalm 9:3 When mine enemies are turned back, they shall fall and perish at thy presence.
11. Psalm 9:4 For thou hast maintained my right and my cause; thou satest in the throne judging right.
12. **Psalm 9:5** Thou hast rebuked the heathen, thou hast destroyed the wicked, thou hast put out their name for ever and ever.
13. Psalm 9:6 O thou enemy, destructions are come to a perpetual end: and thou hast destroyed cities; their memorial is perished with them.
14. Psalm 9:7 But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment.
15. Psalm 9:8 And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.
16. Psalm 9:9 The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble.
17. Psalm 9:10 And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.
18. Psalm 9:11 Sing praises to the LORD, which dwelleth in Zion: declare among the people his doings.
19. Lamentations 3:59 O LORD, thou hast seen my wrong: judge thou my cause.
20. Lamentations 4:11 The LORD hath accomplished his fury; he hath poured out his fierce anger, and hath kindled a fire in Zion, and it hath devoured the foundations thereof.
21. II Timothy 2:1 Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.
22. II Timothy 2:2 And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.
23. II Timothy 2:3 Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.
24. II Timothy 2:4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of *this* life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.
25. II Timothy 2:5 And if a man also strive for masteries, *yet* is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully.
